- 4 Baccalaureate degrees require successful completion of the prescribed curriculum, composed of 45 upper division credit hours, 24 of which must be taken within the major. Students may need to complete 3 additional upper division credit hours of general electives to meet this requirement.

STUDENT ELIGIBILITY: Graduates of Associate of Applied Science- Criminal Justice: Forensic Investigations program at Herkimer Community College must possess a **minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale**.
