COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

FL 101, Spanish I

This course is designed to provide the student with a reading, writing, listening, and speaking knowledge of Spanish. In addition to language skills, the course provides an understanding of the civilization and culture of Spanish-speaking peoples.

MA 124, Contemporary Mathematics

This course is designed to provide students a Liberal Arts Math full of relevance and applications. Topics include inductive and deductive reasoning, finding patterns, fun with sequences, graphing, set theory, linear equations, and linear inequalities. It may also include topics such as introductory concepts in logarithms, geometry, the fundamental counting principle, probabilities, and statistics. Skill in elementary algebra is required.

MA 141, Pre-calculus Mathematics

This course studies polynomial, rational, trigonometric, logarithmic and exponential functions; in particular, the algebra and the curve sketching techniques involved with these functions. Prerequisite: MA 132 or High School equivalent.

SS 244, The U. S. Civil War

This course is designed to familiarize the student with the background, the political struggles, the battle strategies and the aftermath of the United States Civil War. The focus of the course will be multi-disciplinary; economics, sociology, geography, political science and history will all be used to examine the Civil War. Pre-requisite: SS 121 or 122 or permission of instructor.
